\*Note 1: Church Order Article 24-e and its Supplement allow a commissioned pastor emeritus to retain the authority to perform official acts of ministry in ways consistent with their ordination prior to retirement, and allow for transfer of supervision to another congregation with the approval of classis.

*Note 2:* Transfer of the membership of the commissioned pastor emeritus should accompany the transfer of supervision, since the office of commissioned pastor is a local office and does not have denominational standing or scope.

## When processing the Transfer of Supervision for an Emeritated Commissioned Pastor:

- 1. The clerk of the releasing church council is to forward the form to the secretary of the interim committee of the local classis.
- 2. After the interim committee has signed the transfer form, it is to be forwarded to the secretary of the interim committee of the classis in which the emeritated commissioned pastor's new church is located (if not in the same classis).
- 3. After this classical interim committee has signed the transfer form, it is to be forwarded to the clerk of council of the church to receive the transfer, assuming the responsibility of supervision for the emeritated commissioned pastor.
- 4. After the president and clerk of the receiving council have signed the Transfer of Supervision Form, a copy of the completed form is to be forwarded to the secretary of the interim committee of the classis in which the commissioned pastor's new church is located, as well as a copy to the Office of General Secretary (yearbook@crcna.org).
